



### What is Co-creation Lab?

Co-creation Lab is a research and intervention project in the framework of Cultural Ring<sup>1</sup> Latin America-Europe in Uruguay. Collective creation networking throughout advanced internet is the proposal, from transdisciplinary approach in Arts & Science mediated by ICT. The laboratory (Lab) for human and technology experimentation will have a distributed modality, where the participants or Co-creators will be in alive connection from different countries, regions and continents. To access the Co-creator role there are two ways: a Global Call with selection or an invitation letter.

Co-creation means, according to its Latin root, a novelty production together. The features of the Lab imply attractive and unexpected possibilities into the collective intelligence and in personal capabilities of all those motivated to create. Co-creation will take place in Collaborative local and global scenarios provided by several academic networks.

**Who can apply to Global call?** All of those interested whose age is over 18 years old that are studying and/or working related to arts, science, technology and society fields, such as: artists, scientists, engineers, technicians, designers, teachers, makers, among others.

**What does the Lab demand from the participants?** To attend the three online sessions scheduled on 23th May, 4th and 23th September 2019 at 13 to 18 h UYT -3UTC. Besides, to have the availability of one hour per week at least to dedicate to it from May to September. We'll send more information to the applicants.

**What does the Lab offer?** The process in the Lab is free tuition for all participants either for guests or selected applicants or for both of them. The Lab will provide training in the fields mentioned above, for instance co-creation, ICT tools in advanced internet, arts & science projects, performing arts and new media, among many others. The Lab will advise and support in the co-creation processes. Local and global actions of diffusion, interconnection and dissemination of the Co-creators and their productions will be carried out by the Lab. In general, the Lab offers the opportunity to participate in an innovative scenario with relevant international referents with vast experience. Also, the Lab will facilitate the development of: *I*) multicultural learning processes in the generation of new ideas-projects, etc., as well as *II*) skills in ICT mediation in a fertile atmosphere of exchange.
